

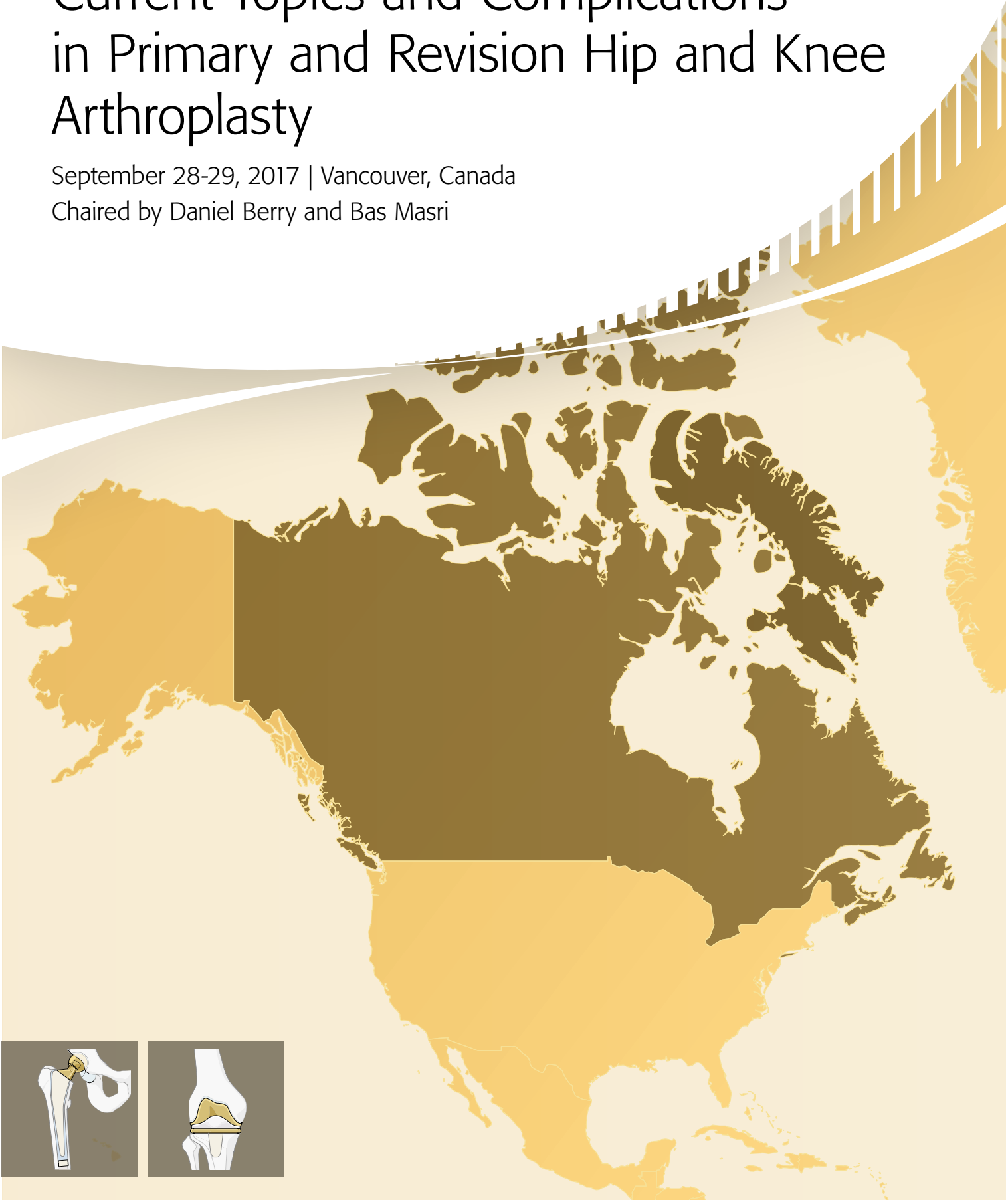


AOREcon & UBC Advanced Symposium
